The Board also reminds all members of the public that while it subscribes, without reservation, to the principle of keeping the community informed, by policy and law, it cannot allow public discussion of personnel matters nor can trustees comment on any current or pending litigation. If a matter concerning an employee of the River Vale Public Schools is of interest or concern to a resident, the matter should be referred to the responsible building principal or the Superintendent of Schools by either telephone or letter.

Meeting opened to public comments at 8:07 P.M.

Mr. Thomas Collins, 188 Richard Drive: Mr. Collins stated that he is appreciative of the work the school district does. Mr. Collins referenced that he was unable to attend the Roberge Community Forum last week, but wished to comment on the Sage Program and Policy 2464 (Gifted and Talented), and voiced his concerns with the District's revisions of the current Sage Program to evolve into the PoGStudio program for next year.

Mr. McCourt, responded that with the reallocation of a staff line in the 2018-2019 budget to create a gifted and talented teacher at both elementary schools, the District Administration recognized that there was a natural opportunity to review and make changes to the current Sage program and increase the opportunities, as well as the rigor for students in the program.

Mrs. Maria Collins, 188 Richard Drive: Mrs. Collins also shared her concerns with the District's revisions of the current Sage Program evolving into the PoGStudio program for next year and wanted to know how the PoGStudio program will differentiate between students.

Mr. McCourt, responded that the PoGStudio program will continue to offer students participating, the opportunity to engage in higher level thinking activities beyond the general education setting, while recognizing the evolving learning environment of our students.

Mrs. Maria Collins, 188 Richard Drive: Mrs. Collins asked who was on the Board Committees and referenced policy 9140 (Citizen's Advisory Board) as well as asking how to get more involved.

Mrs. Lorraine Waldes, Mrs. Waldes responded, Board Committees are comprised of Board Members and when the District was seeking to pass a Referendum, Community forums and surveys were used. Mrs. Waldes also noted the each building's Parent Advisory Committee (PAC), as well Community Forums, represent ways in which the Board and administration gather feedback from parents and communicate information.

Mr. McCourt, responded that Community Forums are a great way of providing feedback to the Board and getting involved, and noted several forums for which parents responses were directly involved in the framing of district initiatives, such as the district's values setting process, and creation of the Portrait of a Graduate.
